The four hundred and thirty second meeting of the American Chemical Society, Susquehanna Valley Section will be held on Wednesday, September 14, 2016 at 7:30 pm in room 301 (Gallery Theatre) in the Elaine Langone Center (LANG) on the Bucknell University campus in Lewisburg, PA. The speaker will be Lou Ann Tom, Ph. D., Associate Professor of Chemistry, Susquehanna University. The talk will be preceded by a reception at 5:00 pm in LANG 241 AB and a dinner at 6:00 pm, in LANG 241 CD.

"Photocatalytic Degradation of Common Pharmaceuticals and Analysis of Susquehanna River Water"

Dr. Lou Ann Tom Associate Professor of Chemistry Susquehanna University Selinsgrove, PA

Dr. Tom conducts research in the area of molecularly imprinted polymers (MIPs). Each polymer is designed to remove and allow detection of low levels of the specific molecule for which it was designed. One project involves MIPs designed to detect antibiotics widely used to treat domesticated and farm animals and a concern if detected in environmental waters.

Dr. Tom worked as a chemist/senior scientist at Merck & Co. Inc. for 19 years, holding a variety of positions. Her work there included development and validation of analytical methods, implementation of online instrumentation for improved process control, development of cleaning methods, resolution of batch atypicals and other analytical support as needed for production. She also worked in the wastewater treatment department. Dr. Tom received a B.S. in Chemistry from Lycoming College, an M.S. in Chemistry from Bucknell University, and her Ph.D. in Chemistry from Lehigh University. She is now an Associate Professor of Chemistry at Susquehanna University, where she teaches General Chemistry, Instrumental Analysis and Core Perspectives.

DIRECTIONS TO BUCKNELL UNIVERSITY:

East of Lewisburg:

- 1. Interstate 80 West to Exit 210A
- 2. Route 15 South
- 3. At 11th traffic light (the first light after crossing Route 45 (Market Street)), turn left onto Moore Avenue. (Look for the Bucknell Athletic Stadium on the left.)

South of Lewisburg:

- 1. Take Routes 11&15 North
- 2. When Routes 11 & 15 split, stay on Route 15 (Tedd's Landing is on your right; KMart on your left)
- 3. Approx. 7 miles after Selinsgrove / Shamokin Dam, you'll come to a stop light. Bucknell is on your right. (Look for the Bucknell Athletic Stadium on right.)


West of Lewisburg:

- 1. Interstate 80 East to Exit 210A
- 2. Route 15 South
- 3. At 11th traffic light (the first light after crossing Route 45 (Market Street)), turn left onto Moore Avenue. (Look for the Bucknell Athletic Stadium on the left.)

North of Lewisburg:

- 1. Take Route 15 south
- 2. Once past Interstate 80, turn left on Moore Avenue at the 11th traffic light (the first light after crossing Route 45 (Market Street)). (Look for the Bucknell Athletic Stadium on the left.)
